## Tuesday night meeting

Douthitt will be working on the club Spruce. It is an Englemann Spruce, collected by Andy Smith in 2009 and is estimated to be about 80 years old. The tree was first styled in 2012 and, since then, has been cared for by Greq P. Greg and Jack repotted the tree this spring, putting it back into the same Sara Raynor pot.

The tree had a fungus infection this year which Greg controlled by spraying with Daconil. There was lots of new growth this year and there are plenty of new buds ready for next year, so it is safe to do a restyling this year.

Jack and Greg will wire the tree before bringing it to the meeting. This approach will allow plenty of time to discuss different design options and for Jack to continue the styling of the tree. Future care will also be discussed.



# An Evening with Charlotte Fung Miller

What a delightful evening at the MBS August meeting. Charlotte and her daughter, Kimbirdlee, presented a demonstration of Chinese brush painting. Charlotte began by demonstrating techniques for applying paint to rice paper. Her first three strokes created a bamboo stalk. Several more light strokes added



small details in black. Green strokes added leaves! As Charlotte painted both she and Kimbirdlee talked about the symbolism and Chinese philosophy of nature, serenity and peace that influences Chinese brush painting. As the bamboo emerged Charlotte asked the audience about mixing different colors, and our 5year old guest, Willow (Rita L's Granddaughter) knew all the color combinations used to create brown and purple.

Then Kimbirdlee took the brush and added dragon- flies to the painting with a few brush strokes and dots. This switch over was a first time collaborating on a painting by the mother-daughter team. They explained that their individual styles of painting are very different. They decided to try a collaborative demonstration for our group to make the evening a bit more exciting. The collaborative painting of "Dragonflies among Bamboo" was wonderful.

Charlotte also demonstrated cutting rice paper with water. Brushing a light coat of water along a line, then pulling quickly on the two sides separated it with a fine soft edge. Charlotte explained the way Chinese writing is formed by symbols instead of letters. She painted as she spoke and painted symbols for several numbers, house, farm and water. She told of her experiences as a child going to school in English and then going Chinese school after that and on weekends.

Charlotte studied 9 years of formal Chinese calligraphy and 7 years of Chinese brush painting under Master Lui-Sang Wong of San Francisco. She earned an M.S. degree in nutritional science and a B.A. degree in bacteriology at the University of California at Berkely. She has also taught courses in Chinese art and cooking, her philosophy being, "I will be able to share my heritage with others."

She and Kimbirdlee shared their joy, heritage and creativity in Chinese brush painting with us at the August meeting, perhaps a scroll painting workshop will be something to consider for the future. Thanks to the MBS Board for inviting Charlotte Fung Miller to the August meeting.






