

Kris Z. tells us a bit about 2 trees she has:

Natal Plum - The Natal Plum comes from South Africa where it is used a lot as a fence. Thorny and compact... keeps a lot of critters off your property. As a bonsai it is draught tolerant and can stand a lot of abuse (making it a good tree for beginners). The plums are edible when ripe (but I haven't tried one yet). I have heard from others who have Natal Plums that theirs have never gotten fruit. I must have a great specimen as mine fruits every year! The blossoms are so sweet! This little guy is only about 8" above the pot.





Meyer Lemon - I love flowering / fruiting trees. I have had this Meyer Lemon for a few years. I first got it in hopes I could grow a few lemons to make marmalade. As you can see in the pic below the leaves are falling, but I have 10 lemons that are ripening. I should have a great harvest for my marmalade (which is delicious!) The 'tree' itself is only about 24" above the pot.
