## Thank you for volunteering!

We rely on volunteers to ensure that we have a successful event. Areas needing volunteers include the following:

- **Exhibit:** Help set up tables and skirting, check in the exhibit trees, and help exhibitors tear down and clean up their areas.
- **Raffles:** Help sell tickets, collect and check in raffle items, and set up the tables for the raffle items.
- **Security:** Make certain that all exhibit, demonstration, and workshop areas are secure during the daily events. Ensure that workshop observers remain silent during the workshops. Participants have paid for time with the artist the observers did not.

## Frequently Asked Questions:

**Where should I park and does it cost?** At Lynden Sculpture Garden, the parking lot is to the left (East) of the entrance. If full, offsite parking is available at the Brown Deer Park n' Ride located on Brown Deer road and HWY 43. A shuttle will be available to bring you to Lynden. There is no cost for parking.

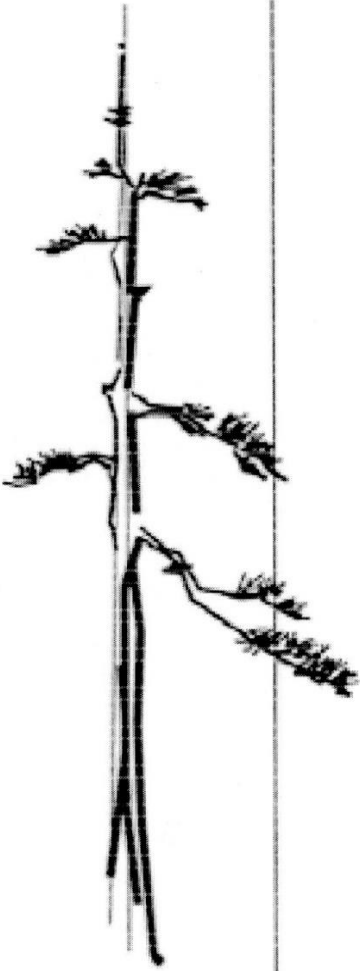
**Do I need a ticket to enter?** No ticket is needed, and no fees will be collected.

**Should I wear my badge?** Yes, please wear your MBS badge. If you have not picked it up at a meeting it may be at the event. Otherwise, blank self-stick badges will be available.

**Who should I look for to get assigned work?** The Check-in person, located at the Check-in Table found near the driveway and walkway to the tents will have the names of all the appropriate contact staff. The Check-in person will be able to direct you to anyone who needs help.
